

Sequoia Tree Facts

- 1. Sequoia trees are one of 3 redwood tree species.
- 2. Sequoia trees are endangered.
- 3. They can live up to 3,000 years!
- 4. The bark can be up to 3 feet thick.
- 5. Sequoias are resistant to fungal rot, wood-boring beetles, and fire.



- 7. The branches can be up to 8 feet in diameter.
- 8. Sequoias used to be logged but are now protected.
- Sequoia wood is brittle and not favorable to use for building.
- 10. The scientific name of the Giant Sequoia is Sequoiadendron giganteum.
- 11. Though sequoias are the largest living organisms on earth, their seeds are among the smallest of any tree.
- 12. The largest living Giant Sequoia is named "General Sherman."
- 13. "General Sherman" is 275 feet tall, weighs 2.7 million pounds, and is 2,200 years old.





Answer: Cl "The President" is the oldest living Sequoia. It is estimated to be 3,200 years old!
